

Come and enjoy a Private tour with Wilderness Wanderer through the Wild Outback of Western Australia in a luxury Landcruiser Safari Wagon. Two or three people on a tour of discovery from Perth to Broome.

**Day 1: Perth – Wooleen (LD)**

Depart Perth and head north through the Mid West region, pausing at the Coalseam at Mingenew before continuing to the overnight stop at historic Wooleen Station in the Murchison.

Overnight: Wooleen Station homestead

**Day 2: Wooleen Station (BLD)**

Full day at Wooleen enjoying life in one of Australia's finest working cattle stations Experience the true outback and if you wish you can join in on station activities. Hear Wadjjarri Dreamtime Stories on the way to sunset at Windijini Rock.

Overnight: Wooleen Station homestead

**Day 3: Wooleen Station (BLD)**

Enjoy the hospitality of Wooleen Station. Delight in the beauty and serenity of the oldest lands in the world.

Overnight: Wooleen Station homestead

Optional extra: 2 nights– Monkey Mia

**Day 4: Wooleen Station– Bidgemia Station (BLD)**

After enjoying the hospitality of Wooleen Station, head north along the Wool Wagon Pathway through the Murchison Settlement and on through Byro Station across the Wooramel River. Soon join the mighty Gascoyne River and follow its course to our overnight stop..

Overnight: Bidgemia Station homestead

**Day 5: Bidgemia Station - Bangemall Inn (BLD)**

Travel to Gascoyne Junction, where the Lyons River meets the Gascoyne, from here travel along the Wool Wagon Pathway to the Kennedy Range. After viewing the rugged Gorges and intricate rock formations follow the Lyons River, pausing to search for ancient fossils on our way to the Kingsford Smith Mail Run which takes us to our overnight stop at the Bangemall Inn established in 1896 to cater for the miners of the El Dorado Gold Mine.

Overnight: Bangemall Inn (Outback Donga's twin share no ensuite)

**Day 6: Bangemall Inn – Mt Augustus (BLD)**

Today we travel only a short distance to Mt Augustus (Burringurrah), the world's largest isolated monocline, (twice the size of Ayers Rock and one billion years old). After exploring around Burringurrah we will spend the night at the Mt Augustus Outback Tourist Resort.

Overnight: Mt Augustus Outback Tourist Resort (Outback Donga's twin share no ensuite)

**Day 7: Mt Augustus – Tom Price (BLD)**

This morning we head along the Pingandy track to the Ashburton River. We travel northwest along the Ashburton River past Ashburton Downs Homestead on the way to Tom Price Motel.

Overnight: Tom Price Motel (twin share, with ensuite)

**Day 8: Tom Price - Karajini (BLD)**

This morning take the Mine Tour then head out to Karajini National Park, the second largest in Western Australia, was 2.5 billion years in the making. Deep winding gorges of marbled rock, emerald coloured pools, spectacular lookouts and the dramatic mood changes of the Hamersley Ranges, stopping at the spectacular Visitor Centre on the way. to our overnight camp at the Savannah Campground Safari Tents.

Overnight: Savannah Campground Safari Tents with ensuite.

**Day 9: Karajini (BLD)**

After a early breakfast head off to explore spectacular Dales, Weano and Joffre Gorges before heading back to camp at Savannah Campground Safari Tents.

Overnight: Savannah Campground Safari Tents with ensuite.

**Day 10: Karajini – Karratha (BLD)**

Travelling via the Tom Price/Dampier railway road we make our way to Karratha, stopping to look at the spectacular scenery enroute.

Overnight: Motel twin share with ensuite.

**Day 11: Karratha (BLD)**

Today spent enjoying the ancient Rock engravings of Burrup Peninsular, viewing the LNG and the Port at Dampier before returning to our Motel

Overnight: Motel twin share with ensuite

**Day 12: Karratha – Marble Bar (BLD)**

Today we are heading to Marble Bar via Pt Headland passing the historic Whim Creek Pub overnight at Marble Bar the hottest town in Australia.

Overnight: Motel twin share with ensuite

**Day 13: Marble Bar – 80 Mile Beach (BLD)**

After viewing the colourful Jasper Bar in the Coongan River we head for the 80 mile beach, a RAMSAR site for migratory birds, crossing the western edge of the Great Sandy Desert with its spectacular scenery.

Overnight: Caravan Park Self contained beach front Bungalow.

**Day 14: 80 Mile Beach - Broome (BLD)**

Today we make our way along the final leg to Broome sightseeing along the way.

Optional extras from Broome could be:

- 1 A visit to the Kooljaman Community at Cape Leveque.
- OR
- 2 A trip through the spectacular Kimberley region including the Gibb River Road and Purnululu National Park.
- OR
- 3 An adventure trip through the Kimberley and Northern Territory via Katherine to Darwin
